<b>Peroni Nastro Azzurro Lager</b> 12 Italy [ABV: 5.1%] <i>Exceptionally crisp, medium bodied. Fresh notes of tangy orange and rye toast.</i>	<b>Weihenstephaner</b> 12 Germany [ABV: 7.5%] <i>Full bodied golden-yellow wheat beer, with a smooth yeast taste.</i>
<b>Big Dog Las Vegas Lager</b> 11 Las Vegas [ABV: 5%] <i>Slightly hopped, pure, and clean. Locally made American-Style Lager.</i>	<b>Hoegaarden</b> 12 Belgium [ABV: 4.9%] <i>Mixed with aromas of orange and coriander, with a straw yellow and naturally murky appearance.</i>
<b>Ninkasi Dawn of the Red IRA</b> 12 Oregon [ABV: 7%] <i>Sweet Tropical Tang gives way to a hoppy finish.</i>	<b>Deschutes Fresh Squeezed IPA</b> 13 Oregon [ABV: 6.4%] <i>Fresh and floral on the nose, with citrus characters that are layered on top of a juicy tropical fruit.</i>
<b>75 Training Day Golden Ale</b> 12 Las Vegas [ABV: 5.75%] <i>Ryan Reeves of the Las Vegas Golden Knights created this hop forward golden ale, with his own love for craft beers in mind. Extremely refreshing with a smooth hop finish, makes for a perfect "gateway" to craft beer.</i>	<b>Left Coast Trestles IPA</b> 13 California [ABV: 6.8%] <i>Clean and pleasantly hoppy, creative and moderately bitter.</i>
<b>Able Baker Test Site Saison</b> 14 Nevada [ABV: 5.5%] <i>Light golden color, aromas of citrus, a bit of yeast and floral notes.</i>	<b>Avery Maharaja Imperial IPA</b> 14 Colorado [ABV 10%] <i>Maharaja is derived from the Sanskrit word Maha, meaning great, and Raja, meaning king. Big imperial IPA is regal, intense and mighty.</i>
<b>Tripel Karmeliet</b> 14 Belgium [ABV: 8.4%] <i>Slightly cloudy appearance. Spicy, smooth finish.</i>	<b>Brooklyn Brown Ale</b> 11 New York [ABV: 5.5%] <i>Hints of cocoa, coffee and caramel swirl beneath a delicate dry-hopped veil of dark-fruit.</i>

<b>Estrella Damm Daura</b> 12 Spain [ABV: 5.4%] <i>Recognized as the best gluten-free beer, obtaining the most prestigious world-renowned awards.</i>	<b>Dogfish 120 IPA</b> 35 Delaware [ABV: 15%-20%] <i>This imperial IPA makes for a perfect finish to your meal. Very rich almost syrupy sweetness. One of a kind and is extremely allocated.</i>
<b>Stella Artois</b> 12 Belgium [ABV: 5.2%] <i>This European Style Pilsner has an attractive golden color with aromas of floral hops and toasted malts.</i>	<b>Innis and Gunn Original</b> 11 Scotland [ABV: 6.6%] <i>Aromas of vanilla and toffee, hints of citrus, with a malty, lightly oaked palate. Balanced and light in texture, soothing and warming in the finish.</i>
<b>Ace Perry Cider</b> 10 California [ABV: 5%] <i>Light and refreshing with huge pear notes on both the nose and palate. Perfect to cool off with after a day at the pool.</i>	<b>Delirium Tremens</b> 16 Belgium [ABV: 9%] <i>Not for the weak-of-palate or the faint-of-heart. Bitter invigorating hops.</i>
<b>Alaskan Amber</b> 12 Alaska [ABV: 5.3%] <i>Fermented in colder weather and at a slower pace than most ambers. This ale has just enough hops that it is rich and malty for a long-lasting balanced flavor on the palate.</i>	<b>Sam Smith Taddy Porter</b> 13 England [ABV 5%] <i>Very dark in color, this Porter is full in body but packed with flavor. Intense, dry tangy character of roasted barley that stands out on the palate.</i>
<b>Dogfish American Beauty</b> 12 Delaware [ABV 6.5%] <i>Dogfish Head and the Grateful Dead both built their following by connecting directly to their fans. This psychedelic pale ale is brewed with granola and wildflower and has notes of honey and citrus.</i>	<b>Dragons Milk Stout</b> 16 Michigan [ABV 10%] <i>A stout with toasty malt character intermingled with deep vanilla tones, all dancing in an oak bath.</i>
<b>Lagunitas Little Sumpin' Sumpin'</b> 11 California [ABV: 7.5%] <i>Super smooth and silky with large hop attributes. Great for both IPA fans and wheat beer lovers.</i>
